

PREVENTION

The best way to keep your stone looking new is to treat it with a high quality stone sealer. Natural stone can be very porous. A sealer will fill in the natural pores and repel spills on the surface, allowing you time to clean up the spill before they have a chance to seep into the stone.



ENHANCE

Some sealers can enhance or darken the stone without adding a shine, for example Stonetech Enhancer Pro. Other sealers such as Glaze and Seal's Wet Look 2000, can enhance the stone's colors while adding sheen to the surface of the stone. These sealers though are not recommended for use outside as they can become slippery when they get wet, unless you add a non slip additive to the sealer when installing it.



CLEAN

Once your stone is sealed, clean up becomes much easier. But you have to be careful what you use on natural stone to clean it. Natural stone needs cleaning products that are specifically made for its unique composition. For everyday cleaning Stonetech's Professional Revitalizer is an excellent choice. It cleans with a gentle, pH-neutral formula that removes soils while reinforcing the original sealer to help upkeep the sealer and prevent future stains. General cleaners that are not specifically designed for natural stone should not be used. These cleaners can breakdown the sealer, etch the stone's polish, and possibly even discolor the stone.



WHAT TO DO WHEN A SPILL OCCURS

No matter how careful you are, spills are going to happen. By using a high quality stone sealer you are adding time to clean up those spills when they do occur. What you should do; Quickly wipe up the liquid with a clean dry white cloth. Spray the area with a stone cleaner, and wipe with a clean cloth. It's that easy when the stone is sealed properly.



OIL STAINS

These are treated differently. They need to be wicked out of the stones pores. Stonetech's Professional Oil Stain Remover is excellent for this.

Things to never do:

- Never let a spill sit on the stone
- Never use a cleaner that contains acid, such as bathroom cleaners, grout cleaners, or tub/ tile cleaners
- Never use vinegar, bleach, ammonia, or other general purpose cleaners
